Greetings to all our Partners in Women's Ministries of ABCOPAD!

One year ago, we sent a mailing to you with lots of information and we received very favorable response from many of you. Today, we want to share with you some of the excitement of all that happened since September 2023.

We are so grateful for your response to our **2023-2024 Region Project** supporting the ministry of Ann and Bill Clemmer in Goma, the Democratic Republic of Congo. Our mission hearted-women and churches of ABCOPAD raised a total of **\$25,137** for the **'Feed My Sheep—Care for My Lambs'** project. **PRAISING GOD & THANK YOU!!**

At the same time, through your generosity, we received \$23,000+ for the 'new' OVER & ABOVE GIVING which supports mission and ministry in ABCOPAD and around the world. We were able to give \$12,000+ to Partners in Ministry ABOPAD Offering; \$1,000 was given to each of our camps, Carmel, Judson and Ichthus; we were able to help 2 women go on mission trips and \$1,000 has been given to be a sponsor of the ABCOPAD Biennial Leadership Conference. THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY!

Through the efforts of Sonie Mervis as Student Loan Coordinator, \$9,000 has been received in loan pay backs since 2022. Though we are no longer officially giving out student loans, with these funds we have been able to support 4 scholarships through Rankin Christian Center, gift \$1,500 to Ricky Smith (son of ABCOPAD missionaries Brian and Lynette Smith) as he begins his first year in college; and provide funds for a woman to begin ACTS program this fall.

THRIVE RETREAT RECAP – 85 women came together in August at Camp Hebron for a time for rest and relaxation. Our focus was RESTORATION, emphasis on REST. Lots of time for fellowship with friends over meals, cookies, smores, hiking, and shopping at our own RETREAT store. Thanks, Jodie, for setting this up and thanks to Karen for overseeing the store throughout the weekend. Worship was once again provided by Ryan and Emily Jeffries (even their kids participated on Sunday morning). Bible Study led by Pastor Kelly Legg was inspiring and brought us closer to our Shepherd as we looked at Psalm 23. There were some 'SHE'nanigans' that went on...The Variety Show was a hit with lots of laughter, tears, wonders and wows!

During the days of Youth Camp, kids will play team sports and games, eat meals together, share in times of prayer, hear Bible stories and sing songs. Inspirational Christian crafts will be made. Each child (ages 6-13 with older youth as helpers) will receive an age-appropriate Bible and a basic electronic tablet preloaded with Bible Apps. These Apps will include quality, edifying videos, games and places they can read and hear enriching stories and the Bible.

The expected impact of this program is for young people to hear the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and a wider, fuller family engagement through what the children are able to take home. Parents and relatives of the children will be encouraged to participate in the entire 10-day program as well.

Chaplain Rick envisions them learning about the joy, power and goodness of God through this experience. His desire is to make disciples, then continue nurturing and arming those new disciples for the many challenges (media, school, schoolmates, etc.) that will beset them in their lives.



Thank you, thank you, thank you for all you do in support of ABCOPAD Women's Ministries.




